COUNCIL WORKSESSION MINUTES

Wednesday, March 22, 2023

On-Site & Virtual via Zoom

A worksession of the Gearhart City Council was called to order by Mayor Smith on Wednesday, March 22, 2023 at 6:41 p.m. immediately following the special city council meeting. Present were Councilor Gould, Councilor Tomlinson, Councilor Fackerell, Councilor Devereaux, City Treasurer Justine Hill, City Administrator Chad Sweet, and Executive Assistant Krysti Ficker.

City Administrator Chad Sweet advised that to start the night's session, Council would first review current goals as they are. Next, he'd highlight departmental goals, followed by Commission goals. Council would also have an opportunity to add goals. He stated that staff would like to focus on goals centered around city operations due to many changes including staffing, policy, and added public pressure. The staff would like to ensure the city is functioning in the most efficient way possible.

Mr. Sweet and Council went through the list of (34+) goals noting duplicates, explaining definitions, discussing specific project updates, and identifying completion percentages and dates.

Council consensus was for each of them to take the goals draft home and prioritize the list. Each Councilor will bring their prioritized goals list back to a future worksession to discuss and formulate the final draft. The final will go to a Council meeting for adoption.

Mayor Smith adjourned the worksession at 8:10 p.m.
