→ BUILDING DEPARTMENT

♦ In 3 ½ years, Gearhart has permitted approximately 106 new homes/dwellings

- → CODE ENFORCEMENT
 - ♦ Working through multiple vegetation and noxious weed cases

 - ◆ Water Conservation Plan draft received and being reviewed → possibility of October worksession
 - ♦ Emergency sole-source procurement → water treatment facility part replacement
