Subject - New Business - Gearhart Clean Up Day

Synopsis: In honor of Earth Day 2023, City staff is requesting permission to hold the Gearhart FREE Clean Up Day on Saturday, April 22nd, 2023. Staff proposes Recology deliver to the area in front of City Hall -- (4) 20-yard drop boxes for trash and (2) 3-yard drop boxes for recycling electronics. The boxes would be available for residents of Gearhart to dump trash at no cost from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m.

Council Options:

- 1) Council resolves to allow Gearhart Clean Up Day;
- 2) Take other action desired by the Council;
- 3) Do nothing.

Recommendation: Staff recommends Councilors resolve to allow the City to hold the clean up day to reduce the amount of trash in the City, and/or improper disposal of electronics.

Legal Analysis: N/A

Financial Analysis: The estimate from Recology is not available yet, however, our application request has been approved. The request stated the same terms as last year. Recology compliance now requires the total tonnage available be quoted. We've been assured that the City of Gearhart has never come close to reaching that amount. Generally, the City's portion and Public Works staff time has been in the \$900 range. Recolgy doesn't foresee an increase.
