## → CODE ENFORCEMENT

## Special Projects / Grants

- → Court Resurfacing this was pushed out; courts will be closed a few days late July/early August
- → Generator project waiting on delivery/installation
- → (2) Cyber Security Grants awarded \$16,696 for Advanced Endpoint Protection and \$18k Immutable Data Backup

- → PSB Architecture & Engineering RFP ends August 6th at 3:00 p.m.
- → Water Rights / Groundwater Modeling Update
  - ◆ The groundwater modeling work is progressing nicely so far with no significant concerns. Still in the data collection phase (no model run yet).
  - ◆ The Water Right Application was submitted under current WRD regulations. The app notes groundwater modeling is coming to support the app.
