We just wanted to take a moment to thank you for making this purchase of the speed monitoring trailer and instituting its use in Gearhart. Speeding on Cottage Avenue and Gearhart Loop has been a problem for many years now and frustrating and disconcerting to us that, seemingly, it couldn't be stopped or at least mitigated somehow.

Because we walk along both Cottage Avenue and Gearhart Loop almost daily now, we have actually witnessed the positive impact the trailer has already made on speeding. People will be driving along in excess of the speed limit, then once they get close enough to the trailer their speed flashes at them and they SLOW DOWN.

The loop walkway/bikeway around the golf course is being used by many people now, especially since people are traveling to the coast in greater numbers since the Governor's lockdown was lifted. All it would take is for a small child on a bike, making a wrong move into the car lane accidentally, for there to be a tragic accident by someone speeding on Cottage who was not able to stop in time due to speeding. Or someone walking their dog and the dog accidentally comes out of its collar and goes into the car lane. Then, of course, there are the deer and the elk that could bound across the road at any time. We never know where they are or when they'll jump into the roadway. Working to keep the speed limit enforced, helps mitigate the possible instances of tragedies.

Again, thank you to all of you for making this wise purchase and putting it into use, for your leadership, and for always working at making our city the best that it can be. We feel lucky and privileged to be Gearhart residents.

Sending a message to city and county offices regarding Census Worker in your Neighborhoods. Starting August 11, 2020 there will be Enumerators in your areas. They will be easily identifiable by their badges and their Census bags. They are required to wear masks and PPE. They will be going door to door to complete the census with people who have not filled out their form.

2020 Census: Soft Launch of Census Taker Visits What Your Community Needs to Know To ensure everyone is counted, census takers visit households that haven't responded yet to the 2020 Census to collect their responses in person. These visits will begin July 16 in communities covered by six area census offices—one in each census region. The U.S. Census Bureau soft launches large-scale operations like this to ensure all systems and procedures are ready to launch nationwide.

Additional areas will soft launch later in July, and the operation will begin everywhere on **August 11**.

All follow-up efforts will conclude no later than October 31.
