



**Resolution # 960**

**A RESOLUTION FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF THE FOLLOWING OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF GEARHART: CITY ATTORNEY, CHIEF OF POLICE, AUDITOR/CITY ADMINISTRATOR, TREASURER, AND JUDGE, AND REPEALING ALL PRIOR ORDINANCES &/OR RESOLUTIONS FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF THESE OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF GEARHART**

The City of Gearhart declares as follows:

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that all prior Ordinances and/or Resolutions fixing the compensation of the City Attorney, Chief of Police, Auditor/City Administrator, Treasurer and Judge of the City of Gearhart and the same are hereby repealed; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Attorney of the City of Gearhart shall be paid a rate of \$235.00 per hour on a as needed basis; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the compensation of the Chief of Police of the City of Gearhart be and is hereby fixed in the sum of \$85,340.11 per year; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the compensation of the Auditor/City Administrator position of the City of Gearhart be and is hereby fixed in the sum of \$95,898.96 per year to be paid from the General Fund Administration; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the compensation of the Treasurer of the City of Gearhart be and is hereby fixed in the sum of \$55,357.50 per year, to be paid \$24,910.88 from the Water Fund and \$30,446.63 from the General Fund Administration; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the compensation of the Judge of the City of Gearhart be and is hereby fixed in the sum of \$250.00 per hour; and

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of the health, peace and safety of the people of the City of Gearhart in order that the City may function and provide water services, legal service, police protection, health protection and have its financial and business affairs taken care of for the benefit of the people of the City, which cannot be done unless payment is made for such services, and this resolution shall be in full force and effect on the first day of July 2021, after its passage by the City Council and approval of the Mayor.
