We have, in the past, received grant money from the city of Seaside and the city of Cannon Beach. These funds have helped greatly towards meeting our needs but fall short of the total coast of our projects.

The Seaside Hall/ Little Yellow House has been a place where people in recovery can have meetings since 1985. Seaside Hall is a 501C3 nonprofit group (ID# 93-1300121) that oversees the operation and management of this facility.

- 1. The people that come to this facility are people looking to recover from alcohol and/or drug addiction.
- 2. They are members of this community from Astoria to Cannon Beach and beyond.
- 3. They are visitors to the area on vacation or business.
- 4. They are patients at one of the several treatment facilities from Long Beach WA to Seaside OR.
- 5. Some are veterans from America's armed forces
- 6. Some are homeless or living in shelters
- 7. We also have court or physician directed attendees.

The number of men and women that attend meetings range from 500-700 a week. Since these are anonymous meetings, we do not ask names or where they are from. A considerable number we have become acquainted with as they are regular attendees and we do know a little about where they are from. The Seaside Hall board also sponsors several functions for the families of our members. We have a July 4<sup>th</sup> picnic and barbeque at Cartwright Park, a Thanksgiving dinner at the Little Yellow House, and a Christmas party for the kids with a Santa visit at the Little Yellow House. The Little Yellow House is known over a large part of the country as visitors have spread the word. We have had visitors say they heard about it and had to come here when they were in the area. The warm and welcoming atmosphere is, in part, the house itself and how it is maintained and, in part, the local members in helping others in recovery. The Seaside Hall Board meets once a month to discuss operational issues and to look at ways to improve the facility. The house is owned by the United Methodist Church next door who lease it to the Seaside Hall. We are on an annual lease with them and have a very good relationship. They like the work we do for the community and the ongoing upkeep of the building.

Our project for this year is to make repairs to the siding and the roof area where it meets. Also, to relocate the smoking area to a place more removed from the rear entrance where attendees gather before and after meetings to visit. We also hold barbeques on occasions for members and their families.

Dear Mayor Brown and Gearhart City Councilors,

Helping Hands was founded in 2002 by Alan Evans, who continues to serve as the organization's CEO. Alan was homeless for over 25 years, and despite knocking on every door he could find, was unable to get the help he needed to overcome the obstacles he faced to successfully reentering society. He was arrested in 2002 in Seaside, and for the first time, a police officer recognized that Alan was not a criminal, but he needed help. He started this organization with \$40 and a whole lot of hope to offer others what he so desperately needed: a helping hand to a sustainable life through resources, recovery, and reentry.

We're proud of the work we do in our community—our Clatsop County facility serves as the best practice model for homeless reentry and is inspiring change on state and national levels. We provide services in four counties in Oregon, with 35% of our services provided right here in Clatsop County, where we serve up to 80 people each night. In 2019, we helped more individuals than ever before, including a significant increase in services provided to families with children and senior citizens.

Clatsop County has the highest homeless rate per capita in the state of Oregon, according to a 2019 study published by the Oregon Health Authority. At Helping Hands, we help these vulnerable citizens build the skills they need to break the cycle of homelessness and become active participants in our local community and economy. We offer referral-only emergency shelter, but our primary focus is on our long-term, trauma-informed, data-driven reentry program designed to build self-sufficiency and provide participants with the skills and confidence they need to independently sustain health and housing upon graduation.

Utilization statistics for 2019 in Clatsop County are as follows:

- 10,166 overnight stays in emergency shelter provided
- 14,538 healthy meals served
- 603 skill-building classes taught on site, not including Anonymous meetings, for which no roster is kept
- 584 unique individuals served

All residents of Clatsop County benefit from our services indirectly. People who are living on the streets have a safe and supportive place to go to turn their lives around and become productive members of the community, making Clatsop County a better place for everyone. We work closely with local law enforcement, as public safety is our priority in every community we serve, and our campuses are strictly sober; participants take frequent drug and alcohol tests. This means a safer Clatsop County.

Thank you for considering this request to support our programs. When we work collaboratively to provide solutions to complex issues, we create a stronger, healthier community for everyone.

So, most are just a step away from making ends meet. 365were new clients this year. In addition, we received almost 52,000 pounds of U.S.D.A. free food products which enabled us to give more and serve the additional clients who needed food assistance this year.

SVDP has always been a "grass roots" organization. Each conference has a group of volunteers who meet regularly and do the actual outreach of the Society. These small geographically located groups are called <u>conferences</u>.

North Coast Food Web (NCFW) was founded in 2011 as a result of the 2010 Clatsop County Food Assessment which underscored the lack of access to healthy, affordable food. Today, 60 percent of Oregonians are considered overweight or obese, with over half the population living with chronic illnesses. With nutritious diet and access to healthy foods being a key component in combating this epidemic, North Coast Food Web adopted the mission to "cultivate healthy communities and a vibrant economy through food and agriculture." We set out to educate, engage and feed families and the community - both at schools and at home. We help build necessary skills to eat healthy at any income level and make informed decisions about individual and family nutrition. We do this through activities such as hands-on cooking classes, educational events at local elementary schools, weekly free healthy snacks and many more. NCFW has been successful at its work thanks to its dedicated volunteers and strong community relationships with organizations like OSU-Extension SNAP-Ed (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program), Providence Medical Center, Columbia Memorial Hospital & Knight Cancer Collaborative, Astoria Co-op, Headstart, CCA Regional Food Bank, and others.
